Cloud Cabinet - Storage Cabinets in Ash & Cherry with engraved Cloud pattern wrapping around the exterior.



Inspired by the open skies by the sea in Wexford where we get amazing sunsets and stormy vistas - these cabinets were designed by Knut to provide plenty of storage, some mood lighting and also to be a bit different.

The technical difficulties presented by the design were tackled by **Andrew Dalton** our Senior Maker. There was a fair amount of head-scratching and thinking before the most efficient method of achieving the wrapped engraving was finally developed and agreed. Andrew put a lot of hours and attention into crafting and decorating the cabinets They are now in their new home in North Dublin. Our clients (who we really want to thank for allowing us to feature the cabinets from design to delivery on our facebook page) are delighted with the pieces and they are now in daily use.







Night Horizon - Writing beaureau in Oak & Maple with an Aluminium inlay

A continuation on from the success of the Cloud Cabinets, the Night Horizon depicts the silvery silhoette of a cloudy dark night. Designed by Knut, the cabinet provides storage space as well as a a writing surface.

Nigel Henderson, one of our senior makers, tackled the manufacture of this cabinet. The making process was made a bit easier by the aluminium inlay and the grooves to recieve it being cut by a CNC machine. The cabinet is on display in the Greenacres Art Gallery in Wexford.
